Decree Holder and his learned advocate are absent when called repeatedly in both sessions. They are absent since long. Present darkhast is pending for steps since long. Record shows that Jangam Warrant has been re-issued on 03.05.2019. Since then the report is awaited. Since long, the darkhast is pending for taking further steps by D.H. It is the duty of the D.H. to take proper steps and proceed further. Original darkhast is of the year 2009 and pending unattended since long. Considering the oldness of the matter, continuous absence of decree holder and its failure to take steps, there is no propriety to keep the matter pending again. So also, the continuous absence of decree holder shows that, decree holder does not want to proceed further with this darkhast. Hence, the following order.

ORDER

1. A.R.D. No. 789/2022 is dismissed in default for want of steps.
2. No order as to costs.
