ORDER

The applicant- accused has applied for regular bail in case FIR No.42 dated 07.04.2026, registered under Sections **305/331(4) of BNS** at Police Station, Thermal, Bathinda

2. It is submitted by the Ld. counsel for applicant/accused that this is first bail application by the petitioner and no similar or similar application for bail under any of the provisions of BNSS has been made before or is pending or has been decided by any Superior Court or any other court. No other petition is pending in High Court either under sections involved or any other section. The accused/applicant has been

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falsely implicated in the above noted case, although he has not committed any alleged offence. There is nothing on file to connect the accused/applicant with the commission of any alleged crime and the accused/applicant has been implicated in the abovesaid case on the basis of mis-guided suspicion. Nothing has been recovered and to be recovered from the person of accused/applicant and the person of the accused/applicant is not required by the police for any purposes. There is no any written complaint by any person against the accused/applicant regarding committing the offence mentioned in the FIR and the accused/applicant was not involved in any criminal activities. The presentation of challan the trial of case will take sufficient long time and no useful purpose will be served by the detention of the applicant in the Jail. Therefore, applicant/accused prayed for bail be granted.

3. The learned APP for the State opposed the bail application and prayed that accused is not entitled to bail as offence U/s **305,331(4) of BNS** is serious in nature and prayed for dismissal of bail application.

ASI Gurmail Singh no.26/Mansa, P.S Thermal has suffered statement that he has brought the record in FIR no.42 dated 07.04.2026 U/s **305,331(4) of BNS** P.S Thermal. Bathinda. No further enhancement of any offence is made out under present FIR till date. This is the first bail application of the accused in present case and no other bail application is pending or decided by any court of law till date as per the record. There is no order so far received from any Ld. Superior Court as to the stay on the arrest of the said accused person or as to the grant of any bail(anticipatory bail).

Date of arrest of accused Rohit Kumar on 07.04.2026. Recovery of one purse in consequence of disclosure statement of accused Rohit Kumar was effected.

The accusations involved in present case are non-bailable in

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nature and does not involve any offence which is exclusively triable by Ld. Court of Session. Or any Ld. Special adjudicated Court of Additional Sessions Judge.

4. This court has heard the contentions of the Ld. counsel for accused/applicant and arguments of Ld. APP for the State.

5. Perusal of record reveals the allegations involved against the accused are serious and grave in nature. This court is of the view that the allegations against the accused are serious in nature. The court is of the view that accused may flee from justice and nature of gravity of accusations involved is serious in nature. The allegations involved against the accused are serious in nature and section 331(4) of BNS is punishable with imprisonment upto 14 years. The allegations against the accused person have tendency to cause public fear and poses the threat to public safety and public piece. Keeping in view the gravity of offence, no ground is made out to give concession of bail to the applicant/accused. Hence the present bail application stands dismissed. Application stands disposed of. Papers be attached with the main file.
