ORDER ON CHARGE

15/04/2025

Present: Mr. Yogendra Adari, Id. Addl.PP for the State.
Accused produced from JC.
Mr. Hari Dutt Sharma, Id. Dy LADC for accused.

1. Arguments on the point of charge heard.
2. Record Perused.
3. Ld. Addl.PP has submitted that there is sufficient material on record for framing of charges against the accused persons as mentioned in the chargesheet.
4. Ld. Counsel for accused person has argued that accused has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is therefore, prayed that the said sections are not made out in the present case and accused may not be charged for the same.
5. Briefly, the case of the prosecution is that accused was found in possession of stolen motorcycle on 01/09/2024 which was reported to have been stolen on 21/08/2024 by

the complainant Shakti. It is also the case of prosecution that on 02/09/2024 the accused got recovered 14 scooties which were stolen from different areas of Delhi and as such the accused was found to be habitually dealing in stolen properties.

6. At this stage, of framing of charge, this Court has to see whether there is sufficient ground for proceeding against the accused. It is axiomatic that even the strong suspicion that the accused has committed the crime, is sufficient to frame the charges. It is also well settled that the standard of proof adhered to at the final decision of the case is not to be adopted at the stage of framing of charge. The court is not to appreciate or weigh the evidence, which the prosecution proposes to lead during the trial.
7. There is prima facie case made out for framing of a charge U/s 317(2)/317(4) IPC against the accused and there is sufficient material on record to proceed against him.
8. Accordingly, charges are framed in the aforementioned sections against the accused namely Amrit @ Don @ Veera to which he pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.
9. List this case for PE for **07/07/2025**. Witnesses at Sl. No. 1 & 2 be summoned for the next date of hearing.
