State Vs. Beant Singh BA-305-2024

This order of mine shall dispose of bail application filed by the accused Beant Singh through counsel Sh. R.S.Abhi Advocate in FIR No. 0106 dated 22.12.2024,U/s 61-01-14 of Excise Act.

2. Notice of application was given to Ld. APP for the State. To which he orally opposed the application.

3. Heard. Record pursued. Perusal of the file reveals that the accused is in judicial custody since 22.12.2024. Conclusion of trial will take time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused in the custody.

4. As such in view of facts and circumstances accused is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) That he will attend the court proceedings on each and every date of hearing and shall not absent himself.
- (ii) That he will not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected.
- (iii) That he will not directly or indirectly make any inducement threat of promise to any person

acquainted with the facts of the accusation his so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer to temper with the prosecution evidence.

Bail application stands disposed off accordingly. Requisite bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Papers be attached with the main file. Copy of this order be sent to the Jail Superintendent, Hoshiarpur.
