Requisite Process Fee for sending process by e-mail in compliance of Rule 14 be also filed within 3 working days alongwith the copies as above for onward transmission to Nazarat Branch, Tis Hazari Courts for service through e-mail.

The written statement has to be filed by the said defendant within 30 days (extendable upto 120 days with the leave of the court and that too subject to appropriate terms) from the date of service of the process as per the Proviso of Sub Rule 1 of Order 5 Rule 1 CPC as applicable to the Commercial Courts Act.
