No reply, in terms of the last order, from the concerned DCP is forthcoming.

Retd. Insp. Ravinder, the then SHO, PS I.P. Estate has submitted that he was transferred from PS I.P. Estate on 30.01.2019 and at that point of time the identity of owner of the vehicle in question and FSL report were pending scrutiny/investigation. Accordingly, Retd. Insp. Ravinder, the then SHO, PS I.P. Estate has submitted that he cannot explain the reason as to why there is delay in filing the present chargesheet.

Request for exemption is made by / on behalf of present SHO on the ground that he has to entered appearance before Hon'ble High Court in case bearing; *Crl. A 818/03, Jaipal Singh v. State and Crl. A 12/04, Usha Mahajan v. State*. For the reasons stated therein, the exemption is allowed for today only. However, no reasons for delay in filing the chargesheet is forthcoming from the present SHO.

At this stage, IO Insp. Bhura Singh has submitted that during investigation, it was noted that no CCTV footage, covering the incident in question could be retrieved and an entry in this regard was made in the first case diary.

This Court has perused the said case diary in Court today, where it is so recorded.

Proof of deposit of cost of Rs.5,000/- by accused Prabhat Kumar along with the affidavit of present address of the said accused has been filed by the accused. Same are taken on record.

Part arguments on charge have been addressed by the Ld. Addl. PP for the State as well as by the Ld. Counsel for the accused persons.

In the interest of justice, list for further arguments on charge on **25.08.2026**.

Issue notice to the concerned SHO to be physically present before this Court on the next date of hearing.

Issue notice to the concerned DCP to be virtually present before this Court on the next date of hearing.

Further, in view of the above, **a copy of the present order and order dated 02.06.2026 be marked to the concerned Joint Commissioner of Police** to look into the conduct of the erring officers and to have a report regarding the reasons for delay in filing the present FIR filed before this Court on the next date of hearing.
