It is submitted by Dr. Charan Singh that the inmate Swapnil has been planned for review at G. B.Pant Hospital for tomorrow for examination/treatment.

Concerned Jail Superintendent and Medical Officer In-charge, Jail No. 1, Tihar, New Delhi are directed to file further/detailed report regarding medical condition and treatment of the accused and future course of treatment alongwith all relevant medical documents on or before the next date of hearing.

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At request of counsel for the accused, the aforesaid interim bail application of the accused be put up for consideration on **21/01/2022 at 12:00 Noon**. Date of 19/01/2022 is given at the specific request and convenience of counsel for the accused.

Dr. Charan Singh, Medical Officer In-charge is bound down with directions to join the proceedings through V.C. on the next date of hearing.

Meanwhile, Jail Authorities are directed to provide the requisite/ necessary/ immediate medical treatment to the accused, as per his medical condition on priority basis. Jail Authorities are also directed to get the accused admitted in the Hospital inside the jail or outside the jail referral/ Govt. Hospitals on priority basis, if required, as per rules. In case, surgery of the accused is required/ planned, the Jail Authorities are directed to make necessary arrangements for the same on priority basis. Jail Authorities are also directed to provide appropriate/ requisite diet to the accused as per his medical condition.

Concerned Medical Superintendent, G. B. Pant Hospital, New Delhi is also directed to provide the requisite/ necessary/ immediate medical treatment to the accused, as per his medical condition on priority basis. Concerned Medical Superintendent, G. B. Pant Hospital, New Delhi is also directed to get the accused admitted in the Hospital on priority basis, if required, as per rules.

Copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent and Medical Officer In-charge, CJ-1, Tihar, New Delhi and Concerned Medical Superintendent, G. B. Pant Hospital, New Delhi for information and compliance.
