2. This is an application filed on behalf of the applicant/accused Kamal Shukla (hereinafter referred to as applicant) for grant of interim bail.
3. It is argued that the applicant is in J.C. since 18.09.2021. It is further argued that after lapse of more than three years, the FSL has not been filed and for that, public witnesses have not been examined. It is further argued that even the contents of the CCTV footage does not support prosecution story because it clearly does not reveal face of alleged culprit. It is further argued that the applicant was never summoned or challaned in any case prior to the present case. It is prayed that the applicant be released on bail.
4. Application has been opposed by the ld. Addl. PP for State on the ground that the allegations against the applicant are

serious in nature. It is further submitted that there are total 23 witnesses and out of 23 witnesses, 14 witnesses have been examined. It is further submitted that during deposition, PW-10 Naresh supported his version and he correctly identified the applicant. It is further submitted that the applicant may threaten the witnesses, if released on bail. It is prayed that bail application of the applicant may be dismissed.

5. Arguments heard.
6. The allegations against the applicant are of heinous offence of murder. The testimony of the eye witness PW-13 Sanib is not yet concluded and the same is deferred for want of CCTV footage which is pending for FSL result. As per prosecution case, the incident is captured in CCTV Footage in which the applicant is seen causing injuries to the deceased.
7. The allegations against the applicant are of serious and grave nature. Considering the overall facts and circumstances, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the applicant.
8. Application of the applicant Kamal Shukla for grant of bail is accordingly dismissed.
9. Application stands disposed of.
10. Copy of this order be given dasti to the IO as well as Counsel for the applicant.
11. Soft as well as hard copy of this order be sent to the

concerned Jail Superintendent for information and necessary action.
