

State vs Rajiv Kumar BA 3008-2021

Record received. Applicant-accused Rajiv Kumar alias Jeewan Kumar son of Satpal filed this bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No. 59/2020, under Section 61 of Excise Act, Police Station Jhander.

The FIR was registered on the basis of secret information that Rajiv Kumar alias Jeewan Kumar son of Satpal used to distill illicit liquor and if raid is conducted, same can be recovered. On this, ruqa was sent to the police station and case was registered. Thereafter, raid was conducted. Accused slipped away from the spot and 55 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered.

Heard. Recovery has already been effected. So, in the meantime, applicant-accused is directed to join the investigation with the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer and on his doing so, he shall be admitted to interim bail by the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer to his satisfaction, subject to compliance of provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Now, for further arguments, adjourned to 07.07.2021. Police record be also produced on date fixed.
