Order no. 2 dt. 03.07.2026

This application for bail u/s 483 of the BNSS filed on behalf of present accused Debjyoti Sannyal in connection with Sandeshkhali P.S. Case No. 279/2026 dated 21.05.2026 corresponding to GR 2805/2026 u/s 448/323/325/384/427/506/34 of IPC is taken up for hearing.

At the outset the Learned Advocate for the accused, petitioner submits that no application for bail has earlier been rejected by the Hon'ble High Court or is pending for disposal before the Hon'ble High Court and he draws attention of this court to the affidavit affirmed in this respect. Ld. Advocate for the accused, petitioner submitted that the accused is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. There is no necessity of custodial interrogation of the accused, petitioner. No fruitful purpose will be served, if the accused is detained in J.C. So, according to him, the accused, petitioner should be released on bail.

The Learned Public Prosecutor in charge submits that there is no indication in the Case Diary suggesting that prayer for bail of the petitioner has either been rejected by the Hon'ble High Court or is pending before the Hon'ble High Court for disposal. However he raised objection against the bail prayer of the accused, petitioner.

Having heard both sides and on perusal of the record, it appears, this is a case u/s 448/323/325/384/427/506/34 of IPC against the accused alleging that on 02.05.2021 the accused took the de facto complainant away and tortured him; the accused snatched his shop room and caused him injury and loss of Rs.8 lakhs. Due to political tension he could not report the matter earlier. There is no specification of time of occurrence and the manner of commission of

the alleged offence has not been properly mentioned in the complaint of information. The offence is Magistrate triable. The accused is in J.C. from 17.06.2026. C.D. reveals no development of investigation since 17.06.2026 to till today as would appear from the page no.16 of the CD. This court has put his signature on the page no.16 of the CD. Considering the bald assertion, no progress of investigation in the CD, this court is inclined him to grant bail.

The accused petitioner namely Debjyoti Sannyal may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs.2,000/- with one surety of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of Ld ACJM, Basirhat, with condition to meet the IO once in fortnight till submission of charge sheet and not to commit and/or indulge in any act similar to the offence for which he has been indicted in this case and not directly or indirectly making any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or the IO or tamper with the evidence.

Thus, the Criminal Misc Case is disposed of accordingly.
