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ORDER BELOW EXH. No.1

Today complainant and his Advocate present. He filed withdrawal purshis at Exh. 04. By way of withdrawal purshis he submits that the present matter settled out of court between the complainant and accused. Therefore he does not want proceed with the matter.

2. The complainant admits the contents of the purshis Exh. 06. The complainant also signed on compromise memo/award Exh.07. Considering the contention made in compromise purshis Exh. 06 and compromise memo/award Exh.07, it appears that the matter is settled between the parties. Hence, the following order.

ORDER

1. Complaint is disposed off as withdrawn.
2. Accused No.1 **Vishal Raghunath Walanj No.2 Raghunath Barku Walanj** is hereby discharged of the offence punishable under section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 vide Section 257 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
3. Court fee refunded to the complainant as per rules.
4. The bail bonds stands cancelled, if submitted by the accused.
5. Award be drawn up accordingly.
