ORDER

31.07.2026

This regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners **Ranjit Rai, Lilku Rai @ Indrajit Rai and Sanjeet Rai**, who are judicial custody since 05.07.2026 in connection with aforesaid case.

Petitioner has mentioned in para 2 of regular bail petition that no bail petition either regular or anticipatory bail except this, is pending before this court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna.

As per FIR, the present case has been instituted on the basis of written report by one Rakesh Kumar alleging therein that on 16.05.2026 at about 09:00 PM, he alongwith his family members including Pankaj Kumar came from Mushrigharari Petrol Pump by private vehicle and got off from the vehicle at Gazipur Chowk and started moving towards his house bare foot and when he reached near the house of Ranjit Rai, then miscreants namely Ranjit Rai (petitioner no. 1), Sanjeet Rai (petitioner no. 3), Gautam Kumar, Golu Rai, Rohit Kumar, Rahul Kumar, Harsh and Lilku Rai (petitioner no. 2) demanded money and on refusal, they started abusing and also assaulted him with lathi, farsa and sword. Further, alleged that Ranjit Rai assaulted to Pankaj Kumar by farsa causing injury. Further, petitioner Sanjit Rai assaulted Vikash Kumar by sword on his head causing serious injury. Further, alleged that Gautam Kumar and Golu Kumar assaulted him with lathi and danda. Further, Rohit Kumar and Rahul Kumar assaulted by Sword to Raushan Kumar.

Learned Counsel for petitioners submits that petitioners are quite innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this false and concocted case and the allegation levelled against the petitioner are wrong and concocted one. The present case is

counter blast of Desari P.S. Case No. 217/2026. It is submitted that all the offences are bailable in nature except the offence u/s 118(i) and 303(2) of BNS which has been added to make the case serious and non-bailable but having no injury. Petitioner No. 1 and 2 has got two criminal antecedents and petitioner no. 3 has got one criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 3 of regular bail petition. It is, therefore, prayed that the regular bail petition may be allowed.

Per contra, the Ld. A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for regular bail.

Heard both the parties and perused the case diary. Para 81, 90, 18, 19, 20 and 21 of the case diary are the statement of witnesses. Further, from perusal of the statement of the witnesses, it transpires that they have stated that assault was made by lathi, danda and occurrence was taken place due to barking of dogs. The injury report of injured Pankaj Kumar, Viki Kumar, Vikash Kumar goes to show that he injuries were caused by hard and blunt substance and the injuries are lacerated wound and bruise.

Therefore, considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as looking into the period of custody and there is also a counter case between both the parties, bail petition filed on behalf of accused petitioners namely **Ranjit Rai, Lilku Rai @ Indrajit Rai and Sanjeet Rai** is hereby allowed and petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only)** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned with following conditions:- (i) *One of the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioners, (ii) Petitioners shall remain physically present in the court till framing of charge and during trial they will be properly represented on each and every date and if they fails to appear on two consecutive dates without any sufficient reason, the prosecution shall have liberty to move for cancellation of their bail bond, (iii) Petitioners shall not be indulged in such a type of offence in future and shall not try to tamper with the prosecution evidence.*
