

Order below Exh-1 in C.C. No. 108/SS/2018.

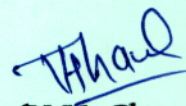
Perused the record. It appears from record that, since last many days applicant and his advocate are continuously absent. The notice was issued but the report was not received by the Court. The applicant is continuously absent and has not taken any steps to proceed further. The repeated opportunities are given to the applicant to proceed with the matter but he has not appeared before the Court and failed to proceed with the matter.

2. From this it appears that, the applicant is not willing to proceed with the matter. In such a situation, there is no justification to keep the matter pending unnecessarily and it would amount to an abuse of process of law. Moreover, in view of letter of Hon'ble Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Esplanade, Mumbai vide no. 6197/2023 dated 21.11.2023 to take special drive to dispose of cases. In the result, I am passing the following order.

ORDER

1. The matter is disposed of under section 256 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
