

ORDERS ON MAIN PETITION

The petitioner has filed this petition U/sec.13(3) of the Registration of Births & Deaths Act 1969.

The facts of the petitioner's case is:-

That the petitioner by name **“Ravikumar C S/o Chandrappa and Lakshamma”** who was born on **29.07.1991** at **Bank road, Near Grameena Bank road, Umblebylu, Shivamogga**, his birth was not registered with respondent authority. When the petitioner approached respondent authority to issue his birth certificate, the respondent issued a non-availability certificate. Hence, he

has filed this petition. After registration of this petition, notice was issued to the respondent. The respondent remained absent. The petitioner filed affidavit in lieu of examination in chief, got examined in chief as P.W-1 and got marked as EX.P.1 to 3. Ex.P.1 is the copy of Non-Availability Certificate dated 21.03.2026, Ex.P2 is the school certificate of the petitioner and Ex.P.3 is the Notarized copy of the ration card. The respondent remained absent for cross-examination of PW.1. Heard the counsel for petitioner and perused all the documents and the evidence, there is no resistance from the respondent and there is no material to disbelieve the evidence of P.W-1. Further on perusal of the Ex.P.2 court found that the petitioner's date of birth is mentioned as **29.07.1991**. Hence, this court in the ends of justice proceed to pass the following;-

ORDER

The petition filed under Section 13(3) of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, is hereby allowed.

The respondent is directed to enter birth event of the petitioner namely “ **Ravikumar C S/o Chandrappa and Lakshamma**” who was **born on 29.07.1991** at in the concerned records and issue Birth Certificate to the petitioner after collecting prescribed fees.

It is clarified that this order shall not be conclusive proof regarding birth event of petitioner namely **“Ravikumar C S/o Chandrappa and Lakshamma”** who was born on **29.07.1991** at **Bank road, Near Grameena Bank road, Umblebylu, Shivamogga**, if it is disputed in any civil or criminal proceedings.

No order as to costs, keeping in view the nature of the petition.
