ORDER:-

The present application has been filed on behalf of applicant namely Randhir Singh for releasing the Vehicle Tractor bearing registration No. PB-23AA-3388, that has been taken into police custody by the police in the above mentioned FIR.

As reported by Ahlmad, investigation of the above-mentioned case is pending.

2. Heard. Record perused.

3. Report from the concerned police station has been received and perused. As per report, the vehicle bearing number PB-23AA-3388 (Tractor) is registered in the name of applicant namely Randhir Singh, S/o Bant Singh, R/o Village Rajindergarh, Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

4. It is clear from the report that the police has no objection if the said vehicle is released on sapurdari in favour of its registered owner/applicant.

5. As per the mandate of case titled as *“Sunderbhai Ambalal Desai VS State of Gujarat, (2002) 10 SCC 283”*, keeping seized vehicles in police stations serves no purpose.

6. In view of the facts of the case and on perusal of police report, application in hand is **allowed** and vehicle in question is ordered to be released to applicant namely **Randhir Singh, S/o Bant Singh, R/o Village Rajindergarh, Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib**, on Sapurdari on furnishing Sapurdari bonds in the sum of Rs. 7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Only) with one surety in the like amount subject to satisfaction of Illaqa/Ld. Duty Magistrate subject to the following conditions:-

- . The applicant shall not sell, transfer, mortgage or dispose of the vehicle in question in any manner, whatsoever and shall not make any change in its body, colour, marks of identification etc. without prior permission of the Court, till disposal of the case, and will produce the same in Court as and when directed.
- . The applicant shall also file an undertaking before this Court that the vehicle in question shall not be used for commission of any offence.
- . Before giving custody of vehicle in question to the applicant, coloured photographs of Cabinet Size from different angles of the vehicle shall be kept on file, and expenses for the photographs shall be borne by applicant.

Sapurdari bonds/surety bonds not furnished.

Present CRM is accordingly disposed of.

Papers be attached with pending remand papers.
