Hence an ad-interim injunction is granted in favour of the petitioners / plaintiffs and as against the respondents / defendants 2 to 4, 9, 10, 14, 24, 27, 30 restraining them not to alienate the petition mentioned properties to 3rd parties till 28.11.2025.
