Submissions heard and record perused.

The plaintiff has filed the present suit for partition as well as permanent injunction against defendant Ved Parkash and Gian Chand. There is another connected matter between the parties bearing suit No. 2020/16 which has been filed by the same plaintiff against defendant Ved Parkash, Neeraj Sharma and Pushpa Sharma for declaration and permanent injunction. It appears that at no stage of hearing, both the matters were clubbed. However, during the deposition of witnesses, copy of evidence recorded in one matter, has been placed in other matter.

It is jointly submitted by counsels of parties that they would inspect the file and intimate the Court if by placing the copy of evidence recorded in one case, in another case, is factually or legally proper or any prejudice has been caused to any of the parties. The other matter is also at the stage of defendant's evidence.

At joint request, the date already fixed i.e. 11.02.2019 stands cancelled and matter is adjourned for **04.03.2020**.
