Nazir has reported that insurance company has deposited the awarded amount of Rs.4,50,000/- in terms of award.

Submissions heard. Petitioner prays that entire award amount may released to him. Considering the facts and circumstances and submission made, the Tribunal is of the view that interest of justice would be served if a sum of Rs.3,00,000/-(rupees three lakhs only) is released to the petitioner immediately and remaining amount of Rs.1,50,000/-(rupees One lakh fifty thousand only) is secured in the form of FDR.

Photocopies of bank details with required endorsement and aadhar card of the petitioner is placed on record. The details are as under :- petitioner Mohd. Zishan Ali savings bank A/c No.20780110247327 (IFSC code: UCBA0002078) of UCO Bank, Karkardooma Courts Delhi.

In view of above, Manager, UCO Bank, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi is directed to transfer a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- (rupees three lakhs) into the aforesaid saving bank account of the petitioner Mohd. Zishan Ali immediately and rest of the amount of Rs.1,50,000/-(rupees one lakh fifty thousand) be converted into one FDR in his name for a period one year.

The FDR be kept in safe custody in UCO Bank and its copy be handed over to petitioner. On maturity of the aforesaid FDR of petitioner the amount be transferred into the aforesaid saving bank

accounts of the petitioner.

A copy of the order be sent to the Manager, UCO Bank, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi for compliance.

A copy of the order be given *Dasti* to the petitioner, free of cost.
