This petition is coming before me for final hearing in the presence of
Sri **P. Prasad**, Advocate for petitioners/accused Nos.3 and 4; and of Spl.
Public Prosecutor for Respondent/Complainant and upon perusing the
material papers on record and upon hearing and having stood over for
consideration till this day, this court delivered the following:

:: O R D E R ::

1. This petition is filed U/Sec.483 of BNSS, 2023 Act by the petitioners/accused Nos.3 and 4 with a prayer to enlarge them on bail.

2. The brief facts of the petition averments are as follows:

(i) That on 07.12.2025 at 19:20 hours at RTO Office, Kunavaram Road, Bhadrachalam, the complainant along with his staff, apprehended the accused Nos.1 to 4 while they were transporting the Ganja through in Ashok Leyland goods carriage bearing No.TS-07-UC-6969 and seized 222.966 kgs of Ganja in the presence of the mediators. On interrogation, the accused persons confessed that they transported the said Ganja with the active support of the accused Nos.5 to 7.

(ii) Basing on the confession and seizure panchanama, the P.S. Bhadrachalam Town registered a case in Cr.No.356/2025 under section 8(c) r/w 20(b) (ii) (c), 27 A and 29 of NDPS Act, 1985.

3. Counter filed by the learned Asst., Public Prosecutor.

4. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners/accused Nos.3 and 4 and the learned Asst., Public Prosecutor.

5. The learned counsel for the Petitioners/accused Nos.3 and 4 submitted that a false case is filed against the Petitioners/accused Nos.3 and 4 with false allegations. The Petitioners/accused Nos.3 and 4 are the sole bread winners of their respective family members, as such, their further detention

would cause much hardship to their entire family. Hence, prays to allow the petition.

6. The learned Asst., Public Prosecutor submitted that Sub-Inspector of Police, P.S Bhadrachalam Town seized (222.966) kgs. of Ganja from the possession of A-1 to A.4 and they confessed the guilt that the Ganja from the accused Nos.5 to 7. Further, submitted that if the petitioners/accused Nos.3 and 4 are released on bail, there is every possibility to continue their illegal Ganja business. Further, they will tamper the evidence and influence the witnesses. Therefore, prayed to dismiss the petition.

7. On perusal of the record it goes to reveal that the Petitioners/accused Nos.3 and 4 are in Judicial custody from 08.12.2025. The object of the bail is to secure the appearance of the accused at the time of trial, and hence this bail is neither punitive nor preventative, deprivation of liberty must be considered as a punishment. Hence, this court is inclined to grant bail to the Petitioners/accused Nos.3 and 4.

In the result, the petition is allowed.

(i) The Petitioners/accused Nos.3 and 4 are ordered to be released on bail on their executing a bond for Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty

Five Thousand only) with Two sureties for like sum each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate of I Class, Bhadrachalam.

(ii) They shall not threaten or intimidate the witnesses and they shall co-operate with the investigating agency as and when required.
