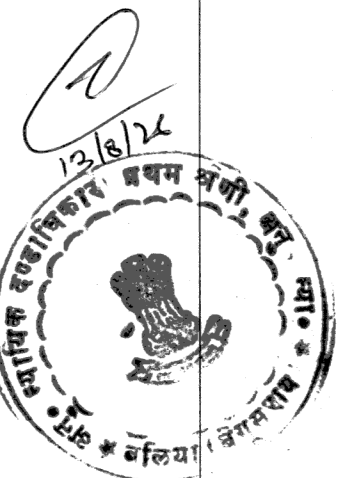

<u>13.08.2026</u>	Case called out. Complainant is absent. Accused persons namely 1) Sanjay Kumar S/o Krishna Kumar Verma Aged 60 years R/o Village Pokhariya, P.S. Sahebpur Kamal, District Begusarai, is present before the court. Perused the record. From perusal it transpires that neither oral nor documentary evidence have been adduced by the Complainant, owing to which it deems fit to pass a following order in this case. <u>Procedural History:</u> The above-named accused person stands charged for having committed offences under aforesaid penal section 323 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. The Complainant case, <i>in brief</i> is that the complainant is a poor widow, law abiding person permanently resident of Village Jahajhdi, PS- Gwalpada, Registry, District Madhepura. She was the owner of the disputed land inherited from her deceased husband. The accused persons, in conspiracy and with dishonest intention, allegedly impersonated another woman as the complainant and fraudulently got Sale Deed No. 1792 dated 11.09.2012 registered in favour of accused No. 1 without her consent,

signature, photograph or receipt of any consideration. Accused No. 2 allegedly identified the impersonating woman, while accused No. 3, the deed writer, was also alleged to be in connivance. On 06.11.2012, when the complainant confronted the accused persons regarding the fraudulent deed, they allegedly abused, assaulted and threatened to kill her and her son. She was allegedly rescued by witnesses and thereafter approached the Officer-in-Charge, Sahebpur Kamal Police Statio. Hence, this case.

After filing of complaint petition SA of complainant was recorded on 01.12.2012. In support of her case, the complainant has examined herself on oath and in her support adduced three inquiry witnesses namely 1) Lallan Kumar Poddar (CW-1), 2) Brahmdev Sahni (CW-2), 3) Kisan Tanti (CW-3) who were examined respectively u/s 202(2) of Cr.P.C. Witnesses have supported the version of the complainant. Inquiry Evidence was closed vide order dated 31.01.2104. Summoning order was passed for the offences punishable u/sec. 323 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 vide order dated 07.07.2014 against the accused namely 1) Sanjay Kumar S/o Krishna Kumar Verma. Thereafter the appearance of the accused person was secured. On 07.02.2026 Substance of accusation for the offence punishable u/sec. 323 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 has been explained to accused person in Hindi, to which, he pleaded not guilty and claimed to be tried. Thereafter, the complainant was directed to

produce witness and for the same. Further, on 06.08.2026, last chance was given to complainant to adduce evidence. However, in spite of grant of sufficient opportunities complainant could not produce even a single witness and therefore, on 12.08.2026 complainant evidence was closed. In light of the fact that no witnesses have been produced by Complainant, on 13.08.2026 statement of the accused person u/sec. 313 Cr.P.C is recorded.

ORDER

Thus, On the basis of above discussion and on perusal of the facts and circumstances and material available on the record I find and it is held that the Complainant has neither adduced any witnesses nor produced any documentary evidence in support of its case and hence it failed to prove any of charge u/sec. 323 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 leveled against the above named accused person.

Hence, the accused persons namely, 1) **Sanjay Kumar S/o Krishna Kumar Verma** is hereby *acquitted* from the offence punishable u/sec. 323 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

- Since, the accused person is on bail, hence his bailors/sureties are also discharged from the liabilities
