This is a Suit for recovery filed by the petitioners claiming themselves to be guarantors in respect of payment of settled loan amount to the bank. Recovery is sought from the borrowers defendant no.1 to 5 and guarantor defendant no.6. Bank i.e. defendant no.7 & 8 had filed the suit for recovery against the borrowers and guarantors before the DRT, wherein the factum of payment by the petitioners was also noted. Counsel for defendants no.1 to 5 submits that subsequent to the said alleged settlement also, defendants no.1 to 5 have received letters from the bank for making payment. It is further submitted that there has been directions to the petitioners herein in the said case to deposit the original documents with the DRT wrongly released by the bank to them but the petitioners have even not complied with the same.
