An application under Order XXII Rule 4 CPC for impleading LRs of deceased defendant No.1 Sh. Ashok Kumar is pending adjudication. Another application under Order XXII Rule 4 CPC for substitution of LRs of deceased defendant no.1 along with application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act filed by LR No.1 of deceased defendant No.1 are pending. Ld. Counsels for the parties submit that they have no objection, if the LRs of deceased defendant No.1 are brought on record.

In view of no objection, LRs of deceased defendant No.1, namely, Ms. Shashi Bala, Sh. Saurav and Ms. Rajni are hereby brought on record. Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

An application under Order VI Rule 17 CPC of defendant No.4 and another application under Order VII Rule 11 CPC of defendants are pending. Ld. Counsel for plaintiff submits that he has not been supplied with the copy of the aforesaid applications. Same be supplied today itself against acknowledgement. Reply be filed within four weeks with advance copy to opposite side.

Settlement efforts made. There are chances of settlement in the present matter.

Request is made for reference of the matter to mediation cell.

At joint request, present case is referred to Mediation Centre, for 30.10.2025 at 2:00 p.m. to explore the possibility of settlement. Both the parties are directed to appear before the Mediation Center on the date and time fixed.

Put up for report of settlement, failing which for arguments on application under Order VI Rule 17 as well as on application under Order VII Rule 11 CPC, on 10.12.2025.
