

**ORDER BELOW THE APPLICATION FOR RETURN OF PROPERTY
IN C.R.NO.101/2018, NOTICE NO.647/N/2018
OF SANTACRUZ POLICE STATION**

1. The applicant is praying for return of VU LED T.V. seized by Santacruz Police Station in crime No.101/2018 registered u/sec.465, 467, 471 r/w. 34 of IPC, sec. 4, 5 Maharashtra Gambling Act.
2. The I.O. filed his say and has given no objection to return the T.V. set to the applicant.
3. The applicant claims to be the owner of the T.V. set. He has produced copy of Voucher regarding purchase in support of his version. He has also produced no objection from the real owner. No one else except the applicant has claimed the custody of the T.V. set. There is no likelihood that the trial will commence soon and conclude in near future. The T.V. set will get damaged if remained in idle condition for longer period. It will be proper to hand over the custody of the T.V. set to the applicant by imposing conditions. In the result, following order is passed.

ORDER

- 1) The application is allowed.
- 2) The custody of VU LED T.V. seized by Santacruz Police Station in crime No.101/2018 registered u/sec.465, 467, 471 r/w. 34 of IPC, sec.4, 5 Maharashtra Gambling Act be handed over to the applicant.
- 3) The applicant to execute indemnity bond of Rs.30,000/-.
- 4) The applicant is directed not to sell, transfer, alter, dispose or hand over the seized T.V. set to third person without prior permission of

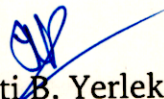
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court and to produce the concerned T.V. set before the Court, whenever required for trial.

5) The Investigating Officer is directed to take the photographs of the seized property, at the cost of the applicant and to produce them with the charge-sheet.

6) The applicant to furnish his photo identity.
