Ld. counsel for plaintiff submits that plaintiff does not wish to file reply to the application u/O VIII Rule 1 CPC seeking condonation of delay of 85 days in filing the WS filed by defendant no.1. He further submits that on instructions from plaintiff, he has no-objection, if the said application is allowed, however, subject to some cost.

In view of the submissions made by Ld. counsel for plaintiff and to decide the lis on merits, the aforesaid application is disposed of as allowed subject to cost of Rs.3,000/- to be paid to the plaintiff on or before the next date of hearing. The WS already filed by the defendants on 30.07.2025 is taken on record.

Replication, if any be filed within eight weeks from today with advance copy to Ld. counsel for defendant no.1.

Original speed post receipt along-with tracking thereof in respect of service of defendant no.2 filed on behalf of the plaintiff. The same is taken on record.

At this stage, Ld. counsel for appearing on behalf of defendant no.2 filed an application seeking directions to plaintiff to supply entire copy of plaint as well as documents annexed with the plaint and also filed the copy of authority letter along-with vakalatnama. The same are taken on record.

Ld. counsel for plaintiff undertakes to supply copy of complete paper-book to Ld. counsel for defendant no.2 during course of the day.

In view thereof, the aforesaid application is disposed of as allowed.

WS be filed by the defendant no.2 within stipulated period with advance copy to Ld. counsel for plaintiff.

On receiving copy of WS, replication, if any be filed within further four weeks with advance copy to Ld. counsel for defendant no.2.

The contesting parties are also directed to file their affidavits of admission/ denial of documents at least one week prior to the next date of hearing with advance copy to each other.

Another application u/O I Rule 10 CPC filed on behalf of the defendant no.2 seeking its deletion from the array of parties of the present suit. The same is taken on record. Copy supplied.

Let reply to said application, if any be filed within eight weeks from today with advance copy to Ld. counsel for defendant no.2.

Put up for arguments on application u/O I Rule 10 CPC filed by defendant no.2 and completion of pleadings/ framing of issues/ proposed issues, if any on **16.03.2026**.
