- 1] Applicant/accused - Nageshkumar Arjunrao Survase has filed application for anticipatory bail u/sec. 438 of Cr.P.C., of the offence punishable u/secs.498-A, 406 r/w.34 of Indian Penal Code, in unknown crime, police station Nhava-Sheva.
- 2] Perused application and say of concerned I.O.
- 3] Heard both Ld. Advocates at length.
- 4] Ld. Adv. for applicant submitted that, applicant is Government servant. He has some family disputes with his wife. Till date, no F.I.R lodged against him. But, he has apprehension that, his wife and son will lodge F.I.R against him. He is public servant and if F.I.R lodged against him, he will be arrested. Hence, he prayed for his anticipatory bail.

5] Say of concerned I.O filed through Ld.A.P.P Shri.Yerunkar wherein, it is specifically mentioned that no FIR filed against the present applicant.

6] I have gone through the application. As per case papers filed by the Ld. Adv. of applicant, there are some family disputes going on between applicant and his wife. He is government servant and he has apprehension that, he will arrest as soon as F.I.R lodged. However, at present F.I.R did not lodge against him. Hence, under such circumstances, the apprehension of applicant has substance and I pass following order.

O R D E R

1. Anticipatory bail Application (Exh.1) is allowed.
2. In the event of arrest, the applicant/accused- **Nageshkumar Arjunrao Survase** be released on bail of the offence punishable u/secs.498-A, 406 r/w.34 of Indian Penal Code, in unknown crime, police station Nhava-Sheva on his executing bond of **Rs.15,000/-with one surety** in the like amount on following conditions -
 - a] He shall attend before Nhava-Sheva Police station for interrogation as and when called by the Investigation officer.
 - b] He shall not meet or pressurize with the prosecution witnesses.

- c] He shall not leave his concerned district without prior permission of this Court.
4. If applicant is unable to furnish any surety during the lock-down period, then he is permitted to deposit surety amount of Rs.15,000/- in the concerned police station and thereafter, he shall furnish surety in the like amount after lock-down period is over before the said police station.
 5. The breach of above condition shall lead to the cancellation of bail.
 6. Inform concerned PSO.
 7. Hamdast allowed.
