This petition is filed by Advocate Thiru C. Saravanan u/s 483
of BNSS, praying to grant bail to the petitioner.

ORDER

Heard both sides. Perused the petition.

2. The petitioner/accused is alleged to have committed the
offences u/s 109(1), 115(2), 118(1), 296(b), 351(3), 61(1) and 3(5) of BNS.

3. The case of prosecution is that the stepfather of the
defacto complainant namely Marimuthu was murdered last year.

Chellamuthu is the younger brother of Marimuthu. About 15 days ago, a man named Madurai Veeran from Salaiputhur was murdered by the uncles of the defacto complainant namely Chellamuthu and Mariappan and now they are in prison. On 02.08.2026 at 9.30 A.M. while the defacto complainant and his wife were having tea under a roadside tree opposite to Krishna Lodge in Mahadhanapuram, the accused persons came in a Tata Ace vehicle bearing Reg. No. TN72 AW 3299 with sickles and the accused Paramasive struck his back with great force meanwhile, accused Paramasivam and Manikandan also armed with a sickle and grabbed his scrotum and abused him in filthy words and the accused Sathaiya and Subbaiah attempted to attack on his neck with aruval, but he escaped by moving away.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he is in no way connected with this case and he has been falsely implicated in this case and the petitioner is under judicial custody from 02.08.2026 and the petitioner is ready to abide by any condition and prayed for bail to the petitioner.

5. The learned Public Prosecutor opposed the application and submitted a report stating that one Marimuthu is the stepfather of the defacto complainant and he was murdered last year. 15 days ago a man named Madurai Veeran was murdered by the uncles of the defacto

complainant namely Chellamuthu and Mariappan and now they are in prison. So there is a previous enmity between them. On 02.08.2026 at 9.00 A.M. the defacto complainant and his wife were having tea at Mahadhanapuram, the accused persons came in a Tata Ace vehicle bearing Reg. No. TN72 AW 3299 with sickles and the 1st accused attacked on the back side of the defacto complainant with the blunt portion of aruval, 2nd accused crushed the private part of the defacto complainant and the 3rd and 4th accused assaulted on his back and shoulder with hand and abused him in filthy words and the 1st and 2nd accused attempted to attack on his neck with aruval, but he escaped by moving away. A1, A2 and A4 were arrested on 02.08.2026 and the vehicle and two aruvals were recovered and the investigation of the case is in the initial stage and he has serious objection to grant bail to the petitioner and the petition may be dismissed.

6. After hearing the rival submissions raised on behalf of both parties, it reveals that already there is a previous enmity between the accused and the defacto complainant regarding the murder case. 15 days ago a man namely Madurai Veeran was murdered by the uncles of the defacto complainant and now they are in prison. So there is a previous enmity between them. On 02.08.2026 at 9.00 A.M. the defacto complainant and his wife were having tea at Mahadhanapuram, the accused persons came in a Tata Ace vehicle bearing Reg. No. TN72 AW 3299 with sickles.

The 1st accused attacked the defacto complainant with the blunt portion of aruval and caused injury on his back. The 2nd accused crushed the private part of the defacto complainant. The 3rd and 4th accused assaulted with hands and caused injuries on his back and shoulder and all the accused abused the defacto complainant in filthy words. Then the 1st and 2nd accused attempted to assault on his neck with aruval, but he escaped by moving away and threatened him. The learned Public Prosecutor strongly objected by saying that the investigation of the case is in the preliminary stage. The occurrence was happened on 02.08.2026. Considering the grievous nature of the offence alleged to have been committed by the petitioner and the investigation is in preliminary stage and this petition is too early, I am of the considered view that it is not a fit case for granting bail to the petitioner/accused at this stage. As such, this petition deserves to be dismissed.

7. In the result, this petition is dismissed.
