PW-29 Rakesh Bhardwaj is present for cross-examination. However, Learned APP for the State submitted that in his examination in chief the number of exhibits have been wrongly typed as Ex.PW19/7 to Ex.PW19/9 and in order to correct the said documents, he wants to recall the said witness in his further examination in chief. On the other hand, the Learned counsels for the accused opposed the said request.

Heard. The said witness has not been cross-examined so far. Moreover, only the number of exhibits is wrongly mentioned in his examination in chief. As such no prejudice is cause to the accused if the said witness is allowed to be recall for his further examination in chief. Further the accused will certainly set the opportunity to cross-examine the said witness. As such, said witness is ordered to be recalled for his further examination in chief.

Further examination in chief and cross-examination of PW-29 Rakesh Bhardwaj conducted. No other PW is present. On request, case is adjourned to 12.09.2023 for remaining prosecution evidence. Let remaining unexamined PWs be also summoned for the date fixed.
