1. Applicant has filed an application under Section 24 of C.P.C. for seeking transfer of the MACC No. 2995/2023 & 2997/2023 pending in the Court of XXXIV Member, MACT Indore and MACC No. 4003/2023 pending in the Court of XVII Member, MACT Indore to one Court.

2. The facts of application in nutshell are that aforesaid

the Motor Accident Cases have arisen out of same motor accident and non-applicants are also same. Some of the issues involved in the above cases are common. Hence, aforesaid the cases should be heard and decided by same Tribunal. Therefore, it has been prayed that aforesaid cases be transferred to one Court. Applicant has filed an affidavit in support of transfer application.

3. Counsel for Non-applicant no.1 & 2 has not filed reply of the transfer application and it is submitted in argument that they have no objection if aforesaid the cases are transferred in one Tribunal.

Point for determination

4. Whether the grounds taken by applicant in application under section 24 of CPC are reasonable, bonafide and sufficient and application is deserve to allowed ?

5. As per mandate of rule 237 of M.P. Motor Vehicle rules, where two or more cases pending before the claims Tribunal arise out of the same motor accident and any issue involved common in two or more cases, such connected cases have to be disposed off by one and same Tribunal.

6. According to both the parties aforesaid the cases have arisen out of same motor accident, non-applicants are also same and some of the issues involved in the cases are common. Looking to the above facts and circumstances, it is appropriate that such cases should be heard and decided by one Tribunal to avoid different findings and awards by different Tribunals.

7. Therefore, after due consideration application u/s 24

of CPC is allowed. MACC No. 4003/2023 pending in the Court of XVII Member, MACT Indore is withdrawn from that Court and transferred to the Court of XXXIV Member, MACT Indore for disposal in accordance with law.

8. A copy of order be sent to both the MACT for compliance.
