ORDER

Today this case came up for National Lok Adalat at the request of the parties. Ld. APP present. Accused alongwith Ld. Counsel present. The accused moved an application for confession to the commission of offence u/s 279/337/338 IPC and pray that the confession of the accused person be recorded and thereafter lenient view be taken. In this regard, the statement of the accused person is recorded under section 242 Cr. P. C and the accused person is explained that he is not bound to make confession and if he wishes to make confession, the same may be used as evidence against him. The questions are put to the accused person and reply sought thereof. Statement be made part of the file and the said statement is signed by the accused person.

After recording the statement of the accused person and questioning him with respect to the confession made by him, I have reasons to believe that the confession made by the accused person in the open Court is the voluntary one and is without any threat or inducement.

From the confessional statement of the accused person placed on record, I am satisfied that he is involved in the commission of the offence under Sections 279/337/338 IPC. Accused person has submitted that he is the first time offender and as such lenient view may be taken against him. The prosecution has not proved any prior conviction and has also not proved that he is the habitual offender, as such lenient view is taken and accused person is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 1000/- for the offence u/s 279 IPC, Rs. 500/- for the offence u/s 337 IPC, Rs. 500/- for the offence u/s 338 IPC total amounting Rs. 2000/- and imprisonment till rising of court. The accused person has paid the fine of Rs. 2000/- vide G.R No. 6993090 dated 09-12-2023 which shall be remitted to Govt. Treasury.
