Upon hearing M/s.D.Dhanasekaran learned Counsel for the Petitioner/Claimant and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/Complainant, I made the following

ORDER

1. This petition was filed by the petitioner under sections 497 r/w 503 of the BNSS seeking interim custody of Redmi 13C Cell phone. B.No. 93/2026, Dated.27.01.2026.

2. The Accused was charged under Sections 303(2) BNS.

3. According to the petitioner he is defacto complainant and above property belongs to him and the same is sought to be returned and that the petitioner is ready to abide by any condition imposed by this court.

4. Notice was ordered to the Respondent Police and APP. The police filed no objection that the case property.

5. Perused the records. On prosecution side not required to sent the cellphone for forensic lab. It is an undisputed fact that the petitioner is the owner. The property

is mobile phone and if it is kept in the Court without use, it would depreciate and it is also not utilized for the purpose of investigation including cyber crime. Having regard to the above facts and the nature of the property being the mobile phone, this Court is inclined to allow the petition on certain conditions.

6. In the result, this petition is allowed on the following conditions:

- (i) That the Petitioner shall execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/-.
- (ii) That the Petitioner shall produce the property as and when required by the Court;
- (iii) That Photographs shall be taken and annexed with the records;
- (iv) That Panchanama (Form 82) shall be duly prepared.

With the above terms, the petition stands allowed.
