J U D G M E N T

This is a case in which final report has been filed by the Sub
Inspector of Police, Sooranadu Police Station in Crime No.
1332/2022 against the accused alleging offence punishable U/s.
118(A) of K.P Act.

2. The accused entered appearance. He was given copy of all
prosecution records. Thereafter the charge for offence u/s.
118(A) of K.P Act was framed, read over and explained to the
accused, to which he pleaded guilty. It is accepted as it is seen
to be voluntarily made knowing of its consequence. So accused
is convicted for the above offence. This is not a fit case for
invoking the benevolent provisions of the Probation of Offenders
Act.

3. Heard the accused on question of sentence. Accused pleaded for leniency. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the view that following sentence will meet the ends of justice.

In the result, accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.500/- only with default imprisonment for 5 days u/s. 118(A) of K.P Act.
