The matter is fixed for final arguments today.

At this stage, an application filed on behalf of the plaintiff U/s 151 CPC seeking necessary directions is taken up.

As per the application, the plaintiff has prayed for one more opportunity to cross-examine the defendant's witness i.e. DW1/ counter-claimant. He further submits that due to non-availability of file on time on the last date of hearing and due to personal difficulty of main counsel, the cross-examination of DW1/ counter-claimant could not be concluded and thus requested for one more opportunity to conclude the cross-examination of DW1/ counter-claimant.

Ld. Counsel for defendant submits that he has examined only one witness in the instant matter and he has no objection, if one more opportunity is granted to plaintiff to cross-examine DW1/ counter-claimant.

In view of the objection given by counsel for defendant, one last and final opportunity is granted to plaintiff to conclude the remaining cross-examination of DW1/ counter-claimant in both the matters.

Accordingly, the application filed on behalf of the plaintiff is disposed of as allowed.

Accordingly, put up for conclusion of evidence before the Ld. Local Commissioner on **16.10.2023 at 2:00 p.m.**

Counsels for both the parties undertake to inform the Ld. Local Commissioner in respect of the date and time fixed for conclusion of the evidence.

At joint request, put up for final arguments on **08.11.2023**. Short date given in terms of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court.
