Bail Application under section 483 of BNSS, 2023**ORDER**

1. Heard on the bail application filed on behalf of the applicant/accused under Section 483 of BNSS for regular bail, in case/FIR no.483 dated 30-12-2025 under Section 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act, PS City Ferozepur, whereby, it is submitted by the applicant-accused that he is quite innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. The alleged recovery has been foisted upon the applicant-accused by forcibly capturing him from his house. There is no compliance of the mandatory provisions of the NDPS Act. The report of the FSL has not been received. The applicant/accused is in judicial custody since 30-12-2025 and no more required by the police for further investigation. The presentation of challan and thereafter its conclusion will take long time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant-accused behind the bars. Accordingly prayer is made for allowing the present bail application.

2. Upon notice Ld. Addl. PP put in appearance on behalf of the State and although reply to the bail application is not intended to be filed by the State

but the said petition is hotly contested by the Ld. Addl. PP for the State and request is made for dismissal of the present bail application.

3. Brief facts of the present case are that on the basis of a secret information received by ASI Gurdev Singh, a nakabandi was laid at the disclosed place and the applicant-accused Sonu was apprehended while travelling in a car bearing registration No.HR-10J-2012 and **448 grams of heroin** was recovered from him.

4. From the perusal of record, it is revealed that the contraband **i.e. 448 grams of heroin was** recovered from the conscious possession of the applicant-accused. The quantity of the alleged contraband **i.e. 448 grams of heroin** recovered from the possession of the applicant-accused, falls under the commercial quantity. Therefore, keeping in view the stringent provisions of Section 37 of the NDPS Act, the applicant-accused is not entitled to the concession of regular bail. As such, the present application for regular bail filed by the applicant-accused is ordered to be dismissed. Bail application file be annexed with the main file/consigned to the Record Room, Ferozepur.
