6. By separate judgment of today's date the instant appeal titled as ***Chander Pal Singh v. Meenakshi Chauhan – CA No. 603/2025*** is **ALLOWED**. The impugned judgment of acquittal dated 28.01.2025 passed by the Ld. JMFC (NI Act)-08, South District, Saket Courts, New Delhi in ***CC NI Act 9023/2023*** is hereby set aside. This Court finds that the appellant/accused miserably failed to rebut the statutory presumptions, and the complainant has successfully proved the case beyond a reasonable doubt.

7. The respondent/accused, Meenakshi Chauhan, is hereby convicted for the commission of the offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

8. Issue notice to the concerned SHO with direction, to file a prior conviction/involvement report of respondent/accused, Meenakshi Chauhan on or before the next date of hearing.

9. Let a copy of the judgment be given to the respondent at free of cost.

10. Now to come up on **31.07.2026**, for hearing the respondent/convict, Meenakshi Chauhan on sentencing.
