There is pendency of more than 41,000 cases in the present court, therefore, it is not possible to give shorter date in the cases.

Matter is listed for report on summons.

Ordinary process not received back. Tracking report filed.

As per the tracking report, accused is deemed to have been served with summons on 22.7.26.

Record reveals that the address of the accused is the one recorded in the customer appointment form. Furthermore, the same is the address reflected in the GST of accused HUF. It appears that after initiation of prosecution, accused has evaded service.

Despite service of summons, no one has appeared on behalf of accused despite repeated calls since morning.

Accordingly, issue bailable warrants against the accused for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- to be executed through SHO concerned returnable to this court on **13.01.27**, only after filing of PF within 8 weeks.
