ORDER

This challan has been presented today by police of P/S **Jhajjar Kotli** after being transferred to this court by Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jammu in presence of the accused person. Report has been called from the concerned clerk and the challan is found complete. The file shall be diarized in the concerned register. Accused has filed an application seeking confession of the offence u/s **281,125(a),125(b) BNS** and is praying this court to take a lenient view in his favour as he is a very young person, a first offender and suffered injuries himself. Accused has been told that he is not bound to make confession but he has insisted for the same. Confession of the accused person seems to be made voluntarily and with his free will. The statement of accused person has been recorded and made part of the file. Keeping in view, the facts and circumstances of the case, the accused person is convicted for the commission of offence u/s **281,125(a),125(b) BNS** and is sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs.1000/-** (Rupees one Thousand only) and a simple imprisonment till rising of the court for the commission of offence **u/s 281 BNS**, a fine of **Rs. 2000/-** (Rupees two thousand only) and a simple imprisonment till rising of the court for the commission of offence u/s **125(a) BNS** and a fine of **Rs. 5000/-** (Rupees five thousand only) and a simple imprisonment till rising of the court for the commission of offence u/s **125(b) BNS**. All the sentences of imprisonment shall run concurrently and the accused person shall be released after rising of the court today. The total fine amount of **Rs. 8000/-** has been deposited by the accused with the Nazir of this court vide **GR No. 1840051** who shall remit the same in the Govt. Treasury. The seized property, if any, shall be disposed of under rules after the expiry of appeal period. The challan is disposed of accordingly. File shall be consigned to record after its due completion under rules.
