Sube Singh Vs. State of Punjab

Report of concerned police station has been received.

Heard on the sapurdari application. As per the report of police, the vehicle in question i.e. motorcycle make Splendor Plus (DRS) bearing registration no. HR-05BM-2572 was taken into police possession in case FIR No. 124 dated 30.06.2026, under Section 281, 106(1) of BNS, PS Sirhind. It is further reported that as per record the vehicle in question is registered in the name of Sube Singh son of Bala Ram, resident of village Birmajra, District Karnal, Haryana i.e. applicant herein and that police has no objection if the said vehicle be released on sapurdari to its original owner.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned APP for the State and have gone through the record with their able assistance carefully and minutely.

It is held by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in number of cases that case property should not be kept in Malkhana for indefinite time and must be released to the person. Moreover it is not disputed that custody to be given to applicant under section 503 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (457 of code of criminal procedure 1973) is only the interim custody till the disposal of the present case.

As per the report of police, the vehicle in question is recovered in the present case and they have no objection for releasing the same to its original owner. The applicant has placed on record copy of registration certificate as well as copy of Two Wheeler Insurance Policy of United India Insurance Company, which shows that he is owner of the above said vehicle in question. Perusal of the application reveals that the present application has been moved by owner of the vehicle in question through his power of attorney namely Avtar Singh son of Sube Singh. Photocopy of the power of attorney dated 18.06.2026 regarding vehicle no.HR-05BM-2572, executed by Sube Singh son of Balla Ram in favour of Avtar Singh son of Sube Singh, has been placed on record. Therefore, I find no impediment in releasing the

vehicle in question to applicant through his attorney Avtar Singh on sapurdari. Accordingly, the vehicle in question i.e. motorcycle bearing registration no. HR-05BM-2572 is ordered to be released on Sapurdari to applicant through his attorney Avtar Singh, on furnishing of Sapurdari bonds in the sum of ₹1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) with one surety in the like amount to compensate the better claimant if arisen in future, with undertaking not to alienate the same till the pendency of this case and to produce the same at his own without prior notice of the court, on each and every date of hearing at the time of recording of evidence. It is made clear that if any better claimant knocks the door of the the court for the custody of the vehicle in question then the applicant shall surrender the vehicle in question before the court. **The Investigating Officer is directed to take the photographs of vehicle showing its number plate, Engine number and chassis number on the expenses of applicant before releasing the same.** Sapurdari application stands disposed of accordingly.

Sapurdari bonds and surety bonds not furnished. The present application be attached with the other papers of the present case.
