Sentence/Order	:	Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of ₹ 500/- for the offence punishable under section 279 of the Indian Penal Code, in default of payment of fine, he shall undergo simple imprisonment for 5 days.

JUDGMENT

Final report was filed against accused by the Sub Inspector of Police, Bongad Police Station, in crime No. 516/2022, alleging offence punishable under section 279 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. Accused & Present He pleaded guilty when particulars of offence were read over and explained to him. I believe that the plea made by him is voluntary. Hence the plea is accepted. Accused is found guilty under section 279 of the Indian Penal Code and convicted for the said offence under section 252 of CrPC.

3. Considering the nature of the offence, I am of opinion that this is not a fit case to apply the benevolent provisions of Probation of Offenders Act.

4. I am of the opinion that the sentence awarded below will meet the ends of justice.

5. In the result, accused is sentenced to pay fine of ₹ 500 /- for the offence punishable under section 279 of the Indian Penal Code, in default of payment of fine, he shall undergo simple imprisonment for 5 days.
