It is submitted by the counsels of the parties that the present case has been settled. As per the settlement, Respondent No.3- insurer has agreed to pay total compensation of Rs.30,50,000/- to the petitioners, within 30 days subject to the award passed by the court. It is further agreed that the delayed payment would entitle the petitioners to receive interest @ 7.5% per annum for the delayed period.

Separate statements of the petitioner Nos. 1 & 2, Ld. Counsel for petitioner No.3 and the Ld. Counsel for Respondent No. 3- Insurer have been recorded in this regard.

Petitioners are directed to get open their bank account (no cheque-book, no ATM) near to the place of their residence and produce relevant documents i.e. bank documents and identification documents on the next date alongwith affidavit regarding their financial status.

The present matter is accordingly referred to the Lok Adalat to be held on 22.03.2026 for passing of the award.
