ORDER BELOW EXH.1

This is an application for regular bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short BNSS). I have heard Ld. Advocate for the applicant/accused and Ld. A.P.P Perused the say filed by the Investigating Officer.

2. Crime No.113/2026 for the offence under Sections 65-E, 83 of the Maharashtra Prohibition Act, 1949 (for short M.P. Act) and Section 123 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short BNS) registered at State Excise Police Station, Pune against the applicant/accused as he along with co-accused was found in possession and selling spurious liquor i.e. adulterated toddy and therefore, crime under above sections has been registered. The applicant/accused is arrested on 09/06/2026 and after initial police custody, he is in Judicial custody since 12/06/2026.

3. As per the applicant/accused he has not committed any offence. In fact, he is not doing the said business, nothing was seized from him and he has no concern with the said liquor. He has family dependent upon him. Already the investigation is almost complete. The properties and articles have been seized. The offences are not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. The offence under Section 123 is not attracted. Except offence under Section 123 of the

BNS all other offences are bailable. He does not have criminal antecedents. He is ready to abide by any conditions if released on bail.

4. Ld. A.P.P. opposed the application and submitted that the offence is serious. This applicant/accused is the owner of the said shop and he along with co-accused was caught on the spot and found in possession and selling adulterated toddy. The investigation is in progress. If released on bail, he will tamper the evidence.

5. Apparently, the investigation is completed. Nothing is to be recovered and discovered from the applicant/accused. The offence is not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. Considering these circumstances keeping the applicant/accused behind bars for indefinite period may not serve any purpose. Therefore, I pass following order :

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. On executing personal bond of Rs.25,000/- and surety in the like amount, the applicant/accused **Tanaji Dnyandev Biramane** be released on bail in crime No.113/2026 for the offence under Sections 65-E, 83 of the Maharashtra Prohibition Act, 1949 and Section 123 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 registered with State Excise Police Station, Pune.
3. The applicant/accused shall not tamper the evidence.
4. The applicant/accused shall not indulge in similar offences while on bail.
5. The applicant/accused shall attend each and every date before the Trial Court unless his absence is excused.

6. The applicant/accused shall furnish his permanent address and mobile number which he shall not change without intimation to the Trial Court.
7. Bail before Committal Court.
