ORDER

File put up before me being Vacation Judge. Present bail
application has been filed by accused/applicants Satnam Singh son of
Gurnam Singh, Amandeep Kaur @ Aman wife of Harpreet Singh and
Gurnam Singh son of Pritam Singh seeking pre-arrest bail under
Section 482 of BNSS. They also filed their affidavits that it is their
first application filed under Section 482 of BNSS.

2. Upon notice, learned APP for the State put in appearance on behalf of the State and contested the bail application. Police record was requisitioned and perused. ASI Lakhwinder Singh No. 2604/BTL, PS Ghuman has appeared along with the record also suffered statement that no other bail application of accused/applicants in FIR No.100 dated 07.06.2025 P.S. Ghuman is pending in any Court and except the offences mentioned in present FIR, no offence has been added and deleted in present FIR.

3. Learned counsel for the accused/applicants submitted that they are innocent and have been falsely implicated in the present case. He further argued that no specific injury has been attributed to the accused/applicants and moreover there is only a superficial injury on the wrist of complainant which is also self inflicted as she was having family dispute with the accused/applicants. Thus, he prayed that accused/applicants may be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail as their custodial interrogation is not required.

4. On the other hand, the learned APP for the State opposed the bail application on the grounds that the accused/applicants had inflicted serious injuries to the complainant and thus their custodial interrogation is required for carrying out effective investigation. On these grounds, they prayed for dismissal of the bail application.

5. After hearing rival contentions of both the sides and after going through the record, this Court finds that present FIR has been

registered against accused/applicants Satnam Singh, Aman and Gurnam Singh as well as one non-applicant Harpreet Singh on the statement of complainant Paramjit Kaur wherein she alleged that on 28.05.2025 at about 10:00 PM, Satnam Singh son of Gurnam Singh armed with datar, Harpreet Singh son of Gurnam Singh armed with datar, Aman wife of Harpreet Singh armed with Saria and Gurnam Singh son of Pritam Singh empty handed entered in her house. Thereafter, her father-in-law Gurnam Singh raised lalkara to teach her a lesson for occupying their land upon which Satnam Singh gave datar blow from its reverse side on her shoulders. Thereafter, Harpreet Singh gave datar blow on her left wrist and Aman gave Saria blow on her left shoulder. She raised alarm upon which her husband Bhagwan Singh reached at the spot and saved her. Thereafter, all the accused ran away from the spot with their respective weapons.

6. As per police record, the injury suffered by complainant on her left wrist has been declared as grievous in nature which is attributed to the non-applicant and is on non-vital part of body of the complainant. So far as, accused/applicants are concerned, no serious or grievous injury has been attributed to them. There is also considerable delay in the registration of FIR as the alleged occurrence is stated to be of 28.05.2025 but FIR was registered on 07.06.2025. Therefore, in the backdrop of these facts, considering

that complainant has not received any serious or grievous injury in the alleged incident and the role attributed to the accused/applicants, this Court is of the opinion that investigation with respect of their role can be carried out without making their arrest and their custodial interrogation is not required. As such, without commenting upon the culpability or non culpability of the accused/applicants Satnam Singh Amandeep Kaur and Gurnam Singh and in order to facilitate the fair investigation, they are directed to join the investigation on or before 26.06.2025 and in the event of doing so, they shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer and accused/applicants are directed to cooperate in the investigation, subject to the following conditions: -

1. That they shall not hinder the ongoing investigation;
2. That they shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court;
3. That they shall not make any threat, promise or inducement to any person conversant with the facts of the case to dissuade him/her from disclosing the truth to the Court or police;
4. That they shall join the investigation as and when asked by the investigating officer,

5. That they shall cooperate with investigation in the matter of present case and further subject to the fulfillment of Section 482(2) BNSS.

However, the observations made herein shall have no effect on the merits of the main case. Police record be returned and now to come on 27.06.2025 for report and consideration.
