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ORDER

1. The brief facts of the case, which require consideration for disposal of the present bail application are that present FIR has been lodged on the basis of ruqa sent by ASI Balvir Singh that on 21.01.2023, he aslong with other police official on private vehicle was present at Joginder Chowk, Moga in connection with patrolling and in search of suspected persons. He received secret information that Surjit Singn son of Avtar Singh, at his karyana store situated near Nestle Gate, Gali No.2, adjoining liquor vend is illegally selling prohibited china thread and with said china thread wings of birds usually damaged and bird became injured and some times, birds die. China thread is harmful for human being also and sometimes due to cut of china thread, human beings are also expired. If raid is conducted at the shop of Surjit Singh, heavy quantity of china thread can be recovered. Finding information reliable, ruqa was sent and FIR was registered. Raid was conducted. Accused-applicant was arrested and from his shop, heavy quantity of china thread was recovered. Thus, present bail application has been filed.

2. I have heard learned counsel for accused-applicant as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor and have gone through the record.

3. Perusal of FIR reveals that on the basis of secret information, raid was conducted at the shop of accused-applicant and heavy quantity of prohibited china thread was recovered from there. Accused-applicant is in

custody since 21.01.2023. Presentation of challan and its conclusion thereof will take considerable time. No useful purpose will be served by detaining applicant-accused in custody. As such, bail application filed by accused-applicant Surjit Singh is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate. Copy of this order be sent to learned Illaqa Magistrate. File be consigned to record room.
