ORDER

1. Vide this common order, three bail applications under Section 482 B.N.S.S, filed by applicants-accused Harjit Singh @ Gurjeet Singh, Shamsher Singh @ Sheru, and Harmandeep Singh @ Harman Singh @ Kalu, seeking pre-arrest bail in the aforesaid FIR, are being dealt with.

2. Applicants-accused, alongwith eight named co-accused (non-applicants) and 2-3 unknown persons, are booked in the present FIR on the statement of Pardeep Singh, son of Daljit Singh, wherein, he alleges that he runs an electronics shop at Adda Dayalpur. On 12.06.2025, at about 9:00 PM, after closing his shop, he was returning to village Kacha Pakka in his Scorpio car, bearing registration No.DL 12 CJ 6376. On the way, near Shaheed Amarjit Singh Memorial, he saw his friend Talwinder Singh, son of Mukhtar Singh, coming on his Splendor motorcycle. He stopped his car and

got out to talk to him. At about 9:30 PM, a white Figo car came and stopped nearby, from which **Harjit Singh (applicant-accused)**, son of Sarwan Singh, and Sukhsimran Singh, son of Daler Singh, alighted. At the same time, Sajandeep Singh, son of Sahib Singh, armed with a datar, Sukhmandeep Singh @ Gori, son of Dayal Singh, armed with kirpan, Harmandeep Singh, son of Gurmukh Singh, armed with a baseball bat, **Shamsher Singh @ Sheru (applicant-accused)**, son of Lakha, armed with a baseball bat, Jashandeep Singh, son of Gurmukh Singh, **Harmandeep Singh @ Kalu (applicant-accused)**, son of Lakha Singh, Daljit Singh, son of Hardev Singh, Nishan Singh, son of Shamsher Singh, Gurbhej Singh, son of Piara Singh, alongwith 2-3 unknown persons who were armed with dang and sticks, came there on 3-4 motorcycles. **Harjit Singh (applicant-accused)** raised a lalkara to teach a lesson to complainant for filing complaints against Harmandeep Singh and Jasandeep Singh over a money dispute. Upon which, Sukhmandeep Singh @ Gori gave kirpan blow to him which hit on his left wrist. **Shamsher Singh @ Sheru (applicant-accused)** gave baseball bat blow to complainant which hit on his back. Sukhsimran Singh @ Raja raised a lalkara that Talwinder Singh also helps complainant Pardeep Singh, and that he should be punished too. Upon which, Sajan Singh gave datar blow to Talwinder Singh, which hit on his left thigh. Harmandeep Singh gave baseball bat blow to Talwinder Singh which hit on his back. As the complainant side raised raula, all the assailants fled away from the spot on the motorcycle of Talwinder Singh alongwith their respective weapons. The reason for attack is that complainant had given Rs.30,000/- to Harmandeep Singh as a loan, which he refused to

return. Due to this, complainant filed a complaint at Police Station Kacha Pakka.

3. Learned counsel for the applicants-accused has contended that applicants-accused have been falsely implicated in the present FIR. It is further contended that applicants-accused have not committed any alleged offence and that applicants-accused are innocent. It is therefore, submitted that applicants-accused, who are ready to join investigation, deserve to be extended the concession of anticipatory bail.

4. On the other hand, learned Addl. P.P. for State, assisted by Sh. A.S. Sangwan, Advocate, counsel for complainant, has contended that there are serious allegations against applicants-accused. As such applicants-accused are not entitled to be released on bail.

5. I have considered the aforesaid contentions raised by learned counsel for the applicants-accused as well as learned APP for the State and the learned private counsel and have also gone through the investigation record.

6. As per FIR, applicant-accused Harjit Singh is alleged to have raised a lalkara, and no injury has been attributed to him. Whereas, applicant-accused Shamsher Singh @ Sheru is alleged to have given baseball bat blow on the back of complainant, and as per MLR, the said injury is simple in nature. There is no active participation attributed to applicant-accused Harmandeep Singh, son of Lakhbir Singh @ Lakha Singh. The main injury attracting Section 118(2) BNS has been attributed to co-accused Sajan Singh. Furthermore, the photographs relied by the

complainant side do not indicate that the same are shared to exert a threat, rather it seems that the person in pictures is displaying his weapons and there being no abusive or threatening material coming on record, it cannot be said that the accused had flaunted his weapons to cause threat to the complainant. Further, there is a delay of 3 days in lodging the FIR as the occurrence is of 12.06.2025 at 09:30 PM, whereas, the FIR was lodged on 15.06.2025 at 11:00 PM.

7. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, applicants-accused are directed to join investigation within 7 days from today and upon their doing so, they shall be released on interim bail by the Arresting/Investigating Officer in the event of their arrest, subject to the following conditions :-

- (i) that the applicants-accused will make themselves available for interrogation by Police Officer as and when required and fully co-operate in the same;
- (ii) that they will not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case, so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that they will not leave India without the prior permission of the Court;
- (iv) that they will produce their phones before the Investigating Officer for investigation purpose.
- (v) that they will not indulge in any nefarious activity.

8. Now the bail applications stand adjourned to 14.08.2025 for

evaluation of outcome of investigation. Nothing discussed herein above shall be deemed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

9. Copy of this order be placed in connected bail applications titled as "Shamsher Singh @ Sheru Vs. State" bearing CIS No. BA/2741/25, "Harmandeep Singh @ Harman Singh @ Kalu Vs. State" bearing CIS No. BA/2742/25.
