Heard on bail application. Perusal of order dated 11.12.2017 passed by this court shows that the applicant-accused was granted interim regular bail with condition that "if the chemical report on receipt would disclose that the case of the applicant falls within the category of commercial quantity then this order granting interim regular bail to the applicant shall automatically be considered cancelled".

2. The applicant-accused has already furnished the bail bonds and surety bonds, which have already been accepted. Hence order dated 11.12.2017 passed by this court is made absolute subject to the condition that if after receipt of Chemical Examiner's report, it is found that, as per allegations, commercial quantity of contraband was recovered from the conscious possession of the applicant-accused, the applicant-accused shall surrender in the court immediately and interim relief shall be deemed to have been declined. The application stands disposed of accordingly. Papers be attached with the main file.
