Sudhir & Ors. ..vs.. Nil

ORDER BELOW EX.1
(Passed on 06/01/2023)

This is an application filed under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation Act VIII of 1827 for grant of heir-ship certificate.

2] In brief, it is contention of applicants that, their father and mother namely Panjabrao Shivramji Adgokar and Kalpana @ Kamal Panjabrao Adgokar died on 11.07.2021 and 21.09.2001 respectively at Anjangaon Surji, Tq. Anjangaon Surji, Dist. Amravati leaving behind the following legal heirs:-

3] On receipt of application, paper publication was issued and same is produced on record at Exh. 10. Applicants also filed on record certified copy of death certificate of their deceased father and mother at Exh. 11, 12 and copy of Aadhar card at Exh. 13 to 17.

4] The period mentioned in paper publication has been expired. During said period or thereafter no objection is received. In support of application, applicant no. 1 examined himself at Exh. 08. He reiterated the contents of application. From the evidence of applicant, it is established that he himself, his brothers and sisters are entitled to recognize as the legal heirs of deceased. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] Issue heir-ship certificate in the name of above persons mentioned in paragraph 2 of this Order being formal legal heirs of deceased Panjabrao Shivramji Adgokar and Kalpana @ Kamal Panjabrao Adgokar on payment of ad-valorem court fees in prescribed form as per rules.
