Today the matter is listed for reply / arguments on the application of petitioners under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 r/w Section 151 CPC.

At the outset, an adjournment is sought on behalf of the respondents, submitting that they do not have the copy of the application. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that he will again supply the copy of the application to the respondents. Respondents are directed to file the reply of the aforesaid application within two weeks from today with advance copy to the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners.

He submits that on that application only, the witness from HPCL may again be summoned.

In view of submissions of Ld. Counsel for the petitioners, let witness mentioned at sr. no.b in the aforesaid application be summoned along with
