ORDER

The above-named accused were forwarded by SHO, Police Station Patran, Patiala to stand trial for having committed an offence punishable under Sections 109, 324(4), 304, 126(2), 3(5) BNS 25,27, 54,

59 Arms Act and Section 238, 61(2) BNS added later on Police Station Patran, Patiala

2. Brief facts of the prosecution version are that on 24.02.2026 the MHC Karandeep Singh hand over MLR No: GS/19/PTR/2026 dated 24.02.2026 reporting that injured Jaskaran Singh, son of Nahar Singh, resident of village Khedi Nagaian, Police Station Ghagga, District Patiala, age about 39 years, to ASI Teja Singh No.1584 PTA. In MLR, Medical Officer doctor recorded that the injured Jaskaran Singh had sustained a total three injuries. Injury No. 01 was kept for surgical opinion; Injury No. 02 for ortho opinion; and Injury No. 03 for surgical/ortho opinion. All the injuries were blunt in nature. ASI Teja Singh 1584/PTA, along with HC Satish Kumar 888/PBI, L/SC, Amandeep Kaur 3521/PTA and PHG Birbal Singh 30080 of Police Station Patran, proceeded on a private vehicle to Civil Hospital Patran. There ASI Teja Singh 1584/PTA presented a written request to the doctor to record the statement of the injured Jaskaran Singh. The doctor declared the injured Jaskaran Singh fit to give a statement. The statement of Jaskaran Singh was recorded that he was a resident of the above address. He has been working in abroad Australia for about 7-8 years. He has one younger brother namely Mandeep Singh, aged about 37 years. On 24.02.2026 at about 11:30 AM, he was to go to his maternal village Sangan (Haryana) from his village Khedi Nagaian. When he reached the new bus stand near Patran, he parked his car bearing registration PB-11-DG-0052 Mahindra Scorpio Classic, black. At that time one white colour another Scorpio was placed in front of his car and Gurwinder Singh alias Guri, son of Amrik Singh,

resident of Ghagga, came out of that white scorio who was carrying a pistol in his hand and hit him on the head with the dub of the pistol, which caused bleeding from his head. At that time Laddi, son of Tara Singh, resident near Gaushala Ghagga, also took out a pistol from his waist and pointed it at him. Meanwhile Amandeep alias Amna, resident Ghagga, took out a gun from his vehicle and attacked him with intent to kill. Thereafter another unknown person took a baseball bat from the car and struck the front glass of the his black Scorio car, due to which front glass of the car was broken. Then people gathered there taking advantage of the situation, the assailants removed a four-tola gold Kada from his right hand and also took away a four-tola gold chain from his neck. They also took expensive glasses from the car. Earlier they demanded ransom of Rs. 50,000/- when he refused they threatened to kill him and gave death threats while they departed with weapons and fled in their vehicle. The injured regained some consciousness and went to Government Hospital on his vehicle where he is under treatment. His statement was recorded. Accordingly, statement was sent for registration of FIR under Section 109, 324(4), 304, 126 (2) 3(5) BNSS and 25, 27, 54, 59 Arms Act through PHG Birbal Singh No.30080. Hence present FIR was registered against Gurwinder Singh alias Guri son of Amreek Singh, Laddi son of Tara Singh, Amandeep Singh alias Amna, resident Ghagga, and one unknown person at Police Station Ghagga, District Patiala.

3. After registration of FIR police started investigation. IO visited place of occurrence. Video recording was made using the e-Saksham app. A certificate under Section 63(4)(c) was made. IO taken

into possession the black Mahindra Scorpio bearing registration PB-11-DG-0052 along with certified photocopies of RC. The case property were deposited in the malkhana. Statement of witnesses were recorded. On 03.03.2026 IO has obtained a mechanical report. The injured's statement was recorded under Section 180 BNS.

4. During investigation on 04.03.2026 the Scorpio PB-11-DG-0052 was handed over to complainant Jaskaran Singh and identification memo was prepared. On 08.03.2026 ASI Teja Singh 1584/PTA, along with Sukvinder Singh 407/PTA and PHG Jashanpreet Singh of Police Station Patran, went in a police vehicle for patrolling and searching of suspected persons. While near the Burra bus stand a secret information received that the accused Amandeep Singh alias Amna, son of Darshan Ram, resident Ward No. 06, Ghagga, Police Station Ghagga, District Patiala, was standing under the Patiala Road bridge near Gurdwara Akalgarh and might attempt to flee. ASI Teja Singh 1584/PTA alongwith police party reached at the spot and saw a young male person wearing a mehroon T-shirt and black pants with slippers who, upon seeing the police party, got perplexed and attempted to flee. He was apprehended by ASI Teja Singh 1584/PTA with the help of police party. On questioning he disclosed his name as Amandeep Singh alias Amna, son of Darshan Ram, Ward No. 06, Ghagga, Police Station Ghagga, District Patiala. He was informed of his name, rank of the officer and the nature of the case and was arrested according to law. He was informed of his right to legal aid. Arrest cum intimation memo of accused Amandeep Singh was prepared. Grounds of arrest were recorded. His personal search memo was also

prepared. Accused was medically examined. Thereafter, he was remanded to judicial custody after seeking police remand. On 01.04.2026 the medical record of the injured Jaskaran Singh was obtained from CHC Patran. On 09.04.2026 medical records were obtained from Rajindra Hospital Patiala by ASI Teja Singh for the injured. On 16.04.2026 the medical opinion regarding the injuries sustained by the injured Jaskaran Singh was obtained from CHC Patran and filed. On 02.05.2026 ASI Teja Singh 1584/PTA and others police officials were present at Police Station Patran when one Dayal Singh son of Chajju Singh, resident Near Singh Sabha Gurudwara Ward No. 02, Pana Ghagga, District Patiala, came to the station and produced a copy of orders passed by Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court Chandigarh, to ASI Teja Singh 1584/PTA. He joined investigation and thereafter vide entry/report No. 38 dated 02.05.2026 an additional offence under Section 238 BNS was added. Thereafter, accused Gurwinder Singh @ Guri was formally arrested, arrest cum intimation memo was prepared and personal search memo was also prepared. Grounds of arrest were recorded. Subsequently, the accused Gurvinder Singh alias Guri was found to possess a firearm license issued from Chandigarh (license no. AF473468, issued 29.08.2025, valid until 28.08.2035) and its certified copy of Arms Licence No. DM/PAT/ARM/GGGA/0117/9 (valid from 04.01.2023 to 03.01.2028) was verified. Two firearms were recovered, one revolver .32 bore and one gun 12 bore and one baseball were recovered from the accused Gurwinder Singh and taken in possession by the IO vide recovery memo. Case property was deposited in the Malkhana. Statements were recorded under

Section 180 BNSS. Upon inquiry by SP Investigation Patiala accused Harpal Singh declared innocent. During investigation accused Mani Singh and Manpreet Kaur were nominated. Thereafter, an offence under Section 61(2) was added later on. After completing all the formalities, present challan was prepared and presented in the court against the accused Amandeep Singh and Gurwinder Singh only.

5. Copy of the challan and all the documents appended with it was supplied to the accused free of cost in compliance of Section 230 BNS and the statement of the accused has also been recorded.

6. After hearing learned learned A.P.P for the State, learned counsel for the accused and have gone through the entire judicial file carefully with their able assistance.

7. From the perusal of the report under Section 193 BNSS and documents attached thereto, it appears that accused have committed offences punishable under Sections 109, 324(4), 304, 126(2), 3(5) BNS 25,27, 54, 59 Arms Act and Section 238, 61(2) BNS added later on. Offence under Section 109 BNSS is exclusively triable by the Court of Learned Sessions Judge, Patiala. Accordingly, this case is committed to the Court of Learned Sessions Judge, Patiala for **07.08.2026**. Accused Gurwinder Singh is present on bail. He is directed to appear before the Court of Learned Sessions Judge Patiala on 07.08.2026. Accused Amandeep Singh is in custody. Jail authorities are directed to produce the accused Amandeep Singh before the court of Learned Sessions Judge, Patiala at 10:00 AM sharp on the date fixed. Learned APP for the State is informed separately regarding the commitment proceedings. Ahlmad of

the court is directed to send the file of this case to the court concerned complete in all aspects well before the date fixed.

Learned APP for the State is informed separately regarding the commitment proceedings.
