**SWATI CHATTERJEE Vs. BHUPENDER SINGH**

Present : Ms.Surabhi Tiwari, Ld. proxy counsel for petitioner with husband of the petitioner.

1. Nazir has reported that in terms of the award dated 23.04.2025, the insurance company has deposited the entire awarded amount alongwith interest to the tune of Rs.1,44,10,506/-.

2. Photocopies of bank details with required endorsement of the petitioner are placed on record. The details are as under :- petitioner Swati Chatterjee savings bank A/c No.0115000100575195 (IFSC code: PUNB0011500) of Punjab National Bank, Alipur Road, Civil Lines, Delhi.

3. As per the directions of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in the order dated 18.08.2025, the insurance company has deposited entire awarded amount. Further, as per the directions in the aforesaid order dated 18.08.2025, 70% of the awarded amount shall be released to the claimants in accordance with the scheme as set out in the Impugned Award.

4. This Tribunal observes that the apportionment of the total award amount is required to be done, so that the 70% of the award amount, may be released to the petitioner then. The perusal of impugned award dated 23.04.2025, it is observed that as per paragraph No.30 of the said award, out of total awarded amount of Rs.91,36,000/-, a sum of Rs.34,00,000/- alongwith corresponding interest (awarded towards artificial limb) was required to be secured in the form of separate FDR and shall be disbursed directly to the Hospital / Agency. Thus, a sum of

Rs.34,00,000/- alongwith corresponding interest shall be secured in the form of one FDR. Further, out of remaining amount of Rs.57,36,000/-, a sum of Rs.28,00,000/- alongwith corresponding interest shall be released to the petitioner immediately and remaining amount of Rs.29,36,000/- shall be secured in the form of FDRs in the name of petitioner Swati Chatterjee as per the following schedule:

5. **It is further clarified that this order on disbursement and the schedule prepared is subject to order dated 18.08.2025 of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.** As per the said order dated 18.08.2025, only 70% of the awarded amount is to be released to the petitioner in accordance with the terms as set out in the impugned award and now the apportionment done. Thus, 70% of the total award amount is to be released to the petitioner as per aforesaid terms and schedule, into the aforesaid saving bank account of the petitioner.

6. The FDRs be kept in safe custody in UCO Bank and its copy be handed over to petitioner. On maturity of the FDRs of petitioner the amount be transferred into the aforesaid saving bank account of the petitioner, without any further order.
7. The rest of the 30% amount of the awarded amount as deposited by the insurance company, shall be secured in the form of one FDR with auto renewal mode.
8. A copy of the order be sent to the Manager, UCO Bank, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi for compliance.
9. A copy of the order be given *Dasti* to the petitioner, free of cost.
10. The present file be consigned to Record Room.
