The matter is taken up today as the scheduled date, i.e., 25.11.2025, was declared a holiday on account of Guru Tegh Bahadur's Martyrdom Day.

Present : Sh. Manoj Kumar, Ld. counsel for the plaintiff along with plaintiff.

An application under Order VI Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC has been filed on behalf of the plaintiff, along with the amended plaint.

Through this application, the plaintiff seeks to amend the plaint.

Learned counsel for the plaintiff submits that the suit was initially filed under Order XXXVII CPC, but was subsequently converted into an ordinary suit. He further submits that, due to this change in the nature of the proceedings, certain consequential amendments became necessary, and the present application has been moved to incorporate those amendments in the plaint.

Heard and considered.

In the interest of justice, the application is allowed and the amended plaint is taken on record. **The application under order VI Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC stands disposed of.**
