On the other hand, the complainant / petitioner submits that he had already provided all the requisite documents to the Investigating Officer in the month of August 2025.

Considering the callus approach of the IO, a copy of this order-sheet be sent to the DCP (East) for initiating appropriate action against the erring official for non-compliance with the directions regarding timely filing of DAR. It is further noted that even today, incomplete DAR has been sought to be filed, which is returned.
